Examination Policy

In addition to the end semester examinations conducted by the University, the College conducts class test and internal test for each semester. It is compulsory for all the students to appear for this test. Marks obtained in the test along with the marks oftheir semester assignment and practical will constitute the total internal marks. Students are warned not to indulge in any unfair means. If anyone is found using such methods, he or she shall be expelled from College with no provision for readmission.

Attendance

Attendance is compulsory for all the students. It is mandatory for all students to attend at least a minimum of 75 % attendance as per the university directive. Any student who does not meet the minimum required attendance will not be allowed to sit for the internal test or external final semester Examination. Students who are continuously absent for 15 days without the permission of the Principal will have his or her name removed from the college register and shall not be re-admitted unless the student furnishes credible reasons for his/her absence.

Discipline

- All students are supposed to bring their College Identity Card to the College
 every day and should produce the said I.D. Card whenever asked for by the
 College authorities. Students will not be allowed to enter the College Campus
 without the valid College I. D. Card.
