Objective and Course Outcome:

Value-added education was formally introduced into the internal curriculum of the college with effect from the 28th March 2022, with the objective of educating students on cross-cutting issues which are contextually relevant and inculcating in them a sense of duty, responsibility and respect for human life, universal human values, the environment, and good citizenry. Value-added education classes are a compulsory part of the college routine and are conducted once a week for forty-five minutes duration.
